You will ALSO find that even ONE word can be a member of several different Parts of Speech depending on how it is used in a sentence. As you read this book, you may find words listed as one form of speech and it also may be listed as another Part of Speech too.

This IS NOT an error. I could not give all of the possible definitions for every word or this book would be hundreds of pages long.

Please consult a dictionary if needed.

Adjectives are words that use the five senses to describe a noun. These are just a few examples; the list is numerous for each of the 5 senses.



What you can SEE

ALL color words are adjectives.

Words that describe size and shape: large, small, tall, short, circular, rectangular, oval, square, thin, thick, bulky, etc.

Words that describe patterns: floral, geometric, linear, etc.

Words that describe appearance: beautiful, happy, bald, hairy, smooth, bearded, pale, flushed, ruddy, dark, light, rosy, blond, brunette, scarred, cute, handsome, muscular, attractive, petite, polished, curvy, stylish, frizzy, wavy, straight, curly, lanky, wiry, tiny, dainty, husky, skinny, plump, etc.


Words that describe behaviors and attitudes: sad, raucous, harsh, brazen, arrogant, prideful, loving, affectionate,

kind, gentle, amiable, friendly, sociable, congenial, meek, angry, calm, hotheaded, ill-mannered, cruel, enthusiastic, encouraging, excited, nasty, shy, friendly, funny, serious, grumpy, happy, tiresome, cantankerous, etc.



• What you can HEAR:

loud, soft, silent, brash, abusive, argumentative, gentle, meek, monotonous, rhythmic, staccato, lilting, mellow, melodic, pure, rich, sweet, earsplitting, noisy, piercing, raucous, roaring, shrill, sharp, etc.



• What it feels like:

rough, smooth, soft, hard, furry, wet, dry, moist, bumpy, lumpy, grainy, satiny, hot, cold, warm, freezing, velvety, cool, etc.



• What it smells like:

stinky, good, yummy, delicious, fragrant, heavenly, smelly, noxious, wretched, delicate, pungent, damp, nauseating, putrid, rancid, rank, sickly, stale, stuffy, savory, fishy, fruity, musky, peachy, smoky, woody, etc.



• What it tastes like:

delicious, delectable, moist, flavorful, bitter, sweet, sour, salty, creamy, citrusy, frosty, crisp, grainy, crumbly, greasy, delightful, gritty, icy, dry, effervescent, juicy, leathery, elastic, lemony, light, fibrous, flat, lip-smacking, flaky, luscious, mild, flavorless, mouthwatering, nutty, foamy, foul, oily, fresh, peppery, zingy, pickled, zesty, refreshing, tough, ripe, tender, rubbery, smooth, stringy, sugary, tasty, tangy, tart, etc.
