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SIMPLE PAST - EXAMPLE 1

PAST REGULARLY SCHEDULED COMPLETED EVENTS

I prayed daily to the Lord Jesus Christ for all mankind.

You played at band rehearsal every Monday, Wednesday, and Friday.

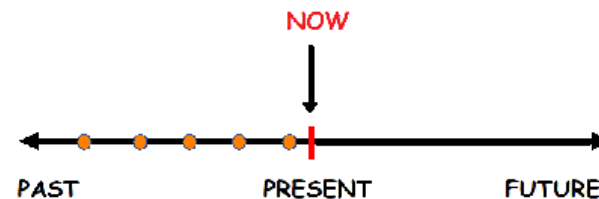
He sprayed the roses weekly with bug spray.

She obeyed her mother by emptying the garbage daily.

The local company employed many people yearly.

We buoyed the spirits of many people daily through our ministry.

They conveyed their subject matter daily through their teaching experiences.



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Simple PAST - Example 2

Using **MORE** Root or Base Word Forms **AND ALSO KEEPING THE Yy AND ADDING "ED."**

Used with **ALL** Pronouns **I, you, he, she, it, we, and they, OR their equivalent.**

I journeyed...

You defrayed...

He played...

She volleyed...

It splayed...

We enjoyed...

They joyed...

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SIMPLE PAST - EXAMPLE 2

PAST - BACK TO ONE POINT IN TIME

I journeyed to the Canadian Rockies in the summer of 2007.

In 2014, you Lord, thankfully defrayed the cost of the Christian Theatre ticket and gave me a blessing ticket.

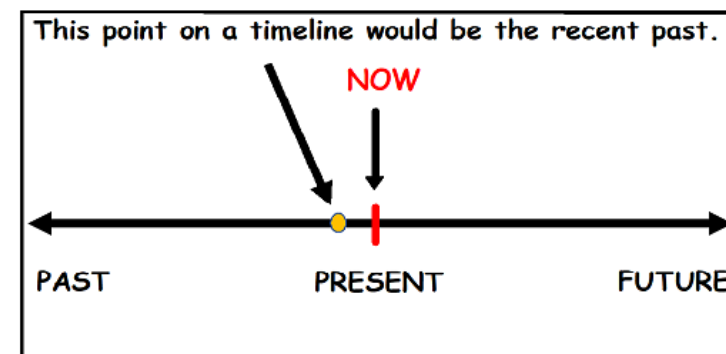
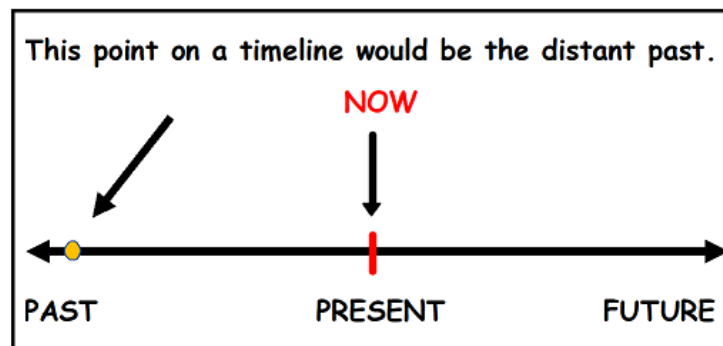
He played his guitar for the recital back in May.

You have deployed...

He has delayed...

She has displayed...

It has destroyed...

We have jockeyed...

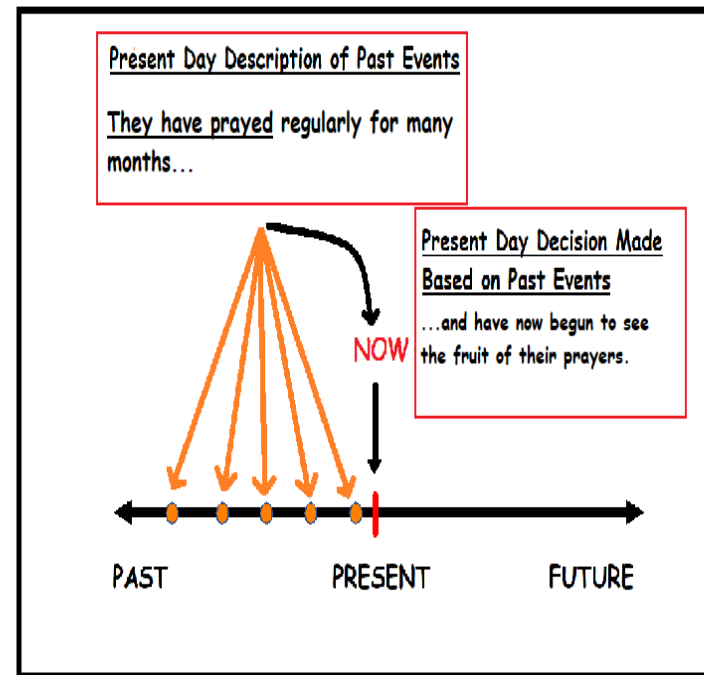
They have prayed...

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PRESENT PERFECT

PRESENT - 1 OR MORE EVENTS IN THE PAST THAT ARE PERTINENT TO THE PRESENT AND MAY/MAY NOT BE AFFECTING EVENTS HAPPENING IN THE PRESENT



I have conveyed the information through multiple lessons and my students understand it!

You have deployed to many places and it's no wonder you have decided to retire.

He has delayed making an announcement over several days, and finally, he has called a press conference.

She has regularly displayed the merchandise so beautifully that they have decided to give her a raise.

It has destroyed several bedspreads by pulling out the filling, so they are making it sleep in the hallway now.

We have jockeyed for a leadership position for 5 years and neither of us got the job.

They have prayed regularly for many months and have now begun to see the fruit of their prayers.

I had replayed...

You had strayed...

He had toyed...

She had hayed...

It had displayed...

We had annoyed...

They had arrayed...

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PAST PERFECT

PAST - A SENTENCE MAKING A COMPARISON BETWEEN HOW 2 OR MORE SEQUENTIAL EVENTS OCCUR IN A PAST TIME FRAME.

I had replayed the vision for the dress over a period of 2 years and then finally made the dress.

You had strayed from God's will over many years and then came to accept Christ as your Savior.

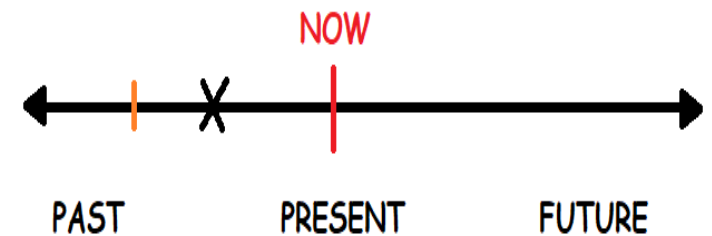
He had toyed with the idea of starting his own business and then finally did accomplish it.

She had hayed the horses before she milked the cows.

It had displayed unusual behaviors before she took it to the vet.

We had annoyed the llamas when we tried to shear them and then they wanted nothing to do with us for a while.

They had beautifully arrayed the food for the banquet and as a result, the people devoured it.

Used with ALL Pronouns I, you, he, she, it, we, and they, OR their equivalent.

I will have sprayed...

You will have obeyed...

He will have grayed...

She will have played...

It will have decayed...

We will have enjoyed...

They will have journeyed...

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FUTURE PERFECT

FUTURE - A SENTENCE MAKING A COMPARISON BETWEEN HOW 2 OR MORE SEQUENTIAL EVENTS OCCUR IN A FUTURE TIME FRAME.

I will have sprayed the ceiling before winter arrives.

You will have obeyed the Lord by going to Africa before I come back from Australia.

He probably will have grayed completely before he turns 70.

She will have played the fish before she cooks it tonight.

The tree will have decayed completely by next summer.

We will have enjoyed our vacation before school starts in the fall.

They will have journeyed to many countries before they are 90 years old.
