SIMPLE PRESENT - EXAMPLE 1

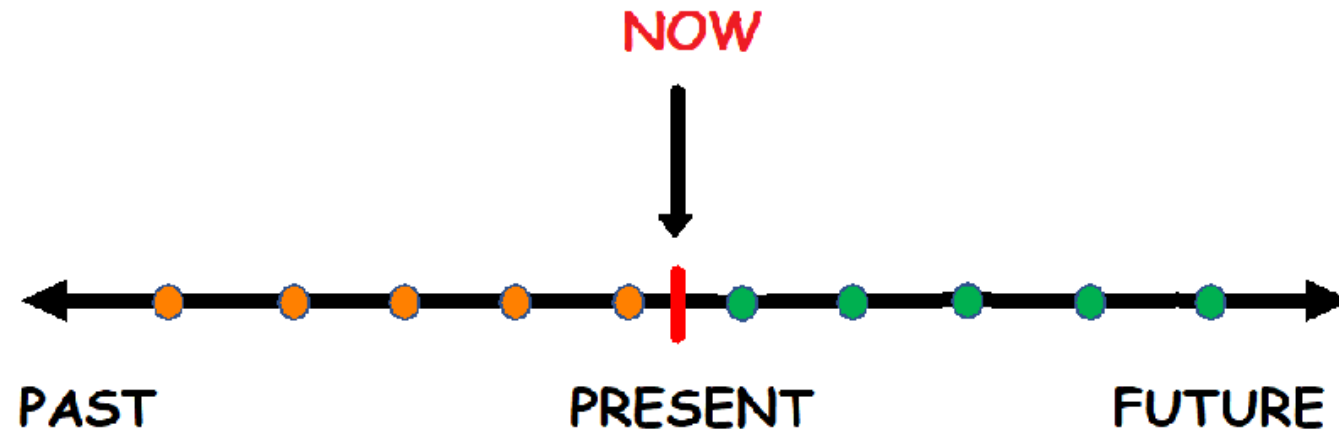
PRESENT REGULARLY SCHEDULED COMPLETED EVENTS

SIMPLE PRESENT - EXAMPLE 2

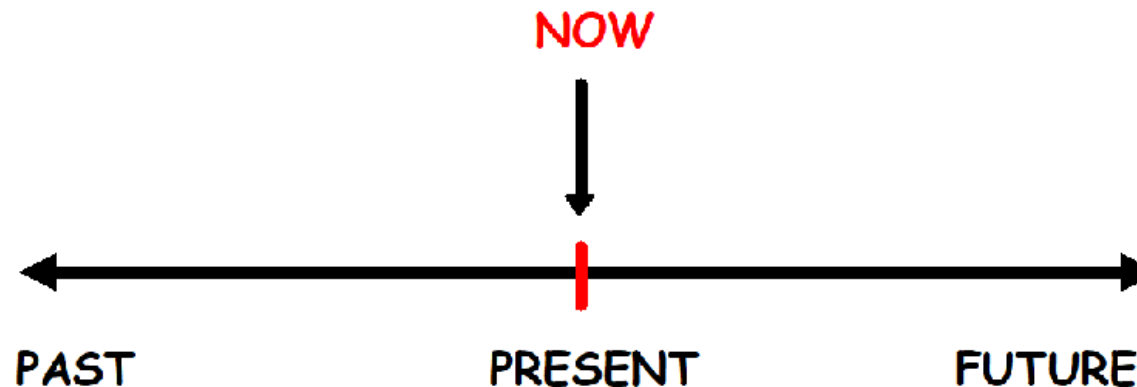
PRESENT NOW - POINT IN TIME

You will hike weekly to lose weight.

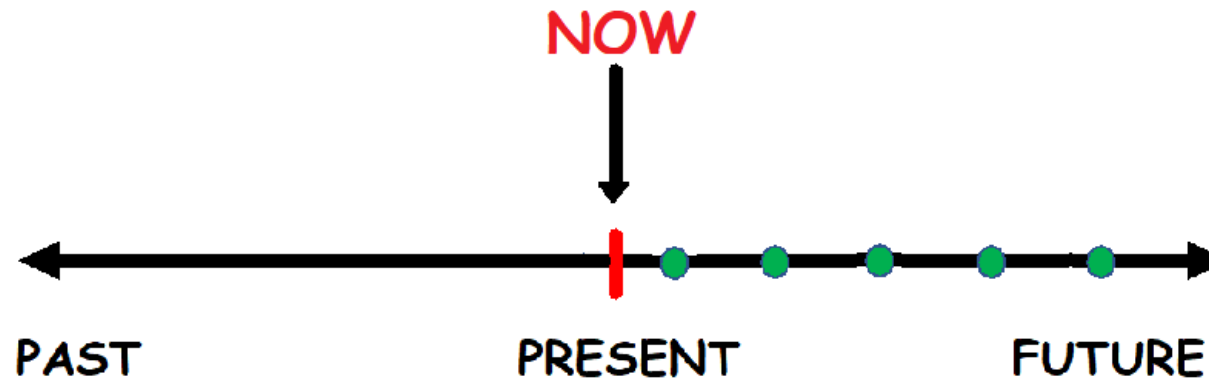
He will house a college student yearly.

He will propose to his fiance on Saturday evening.

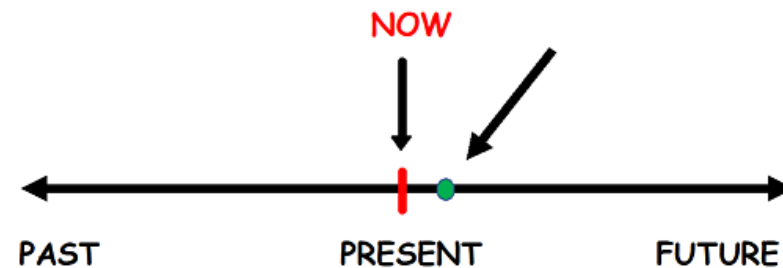
She will race in the marathon on Friday.
