SIMPLE PRESENT - EXAMPLE 1

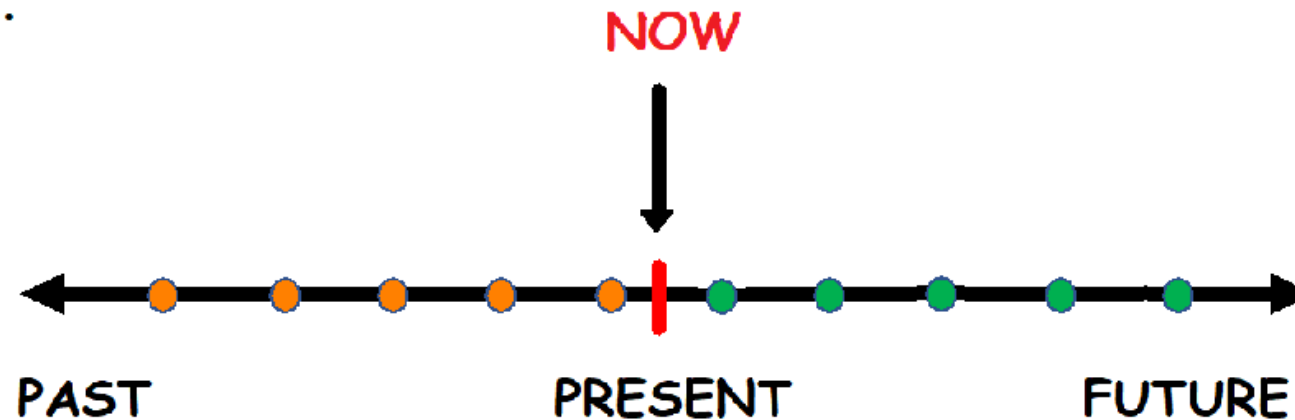
PRESENT REGULARLY SCHEDULED COMPLETED EVENTS

SIMPLE PRESENT - EXAMPLE 2

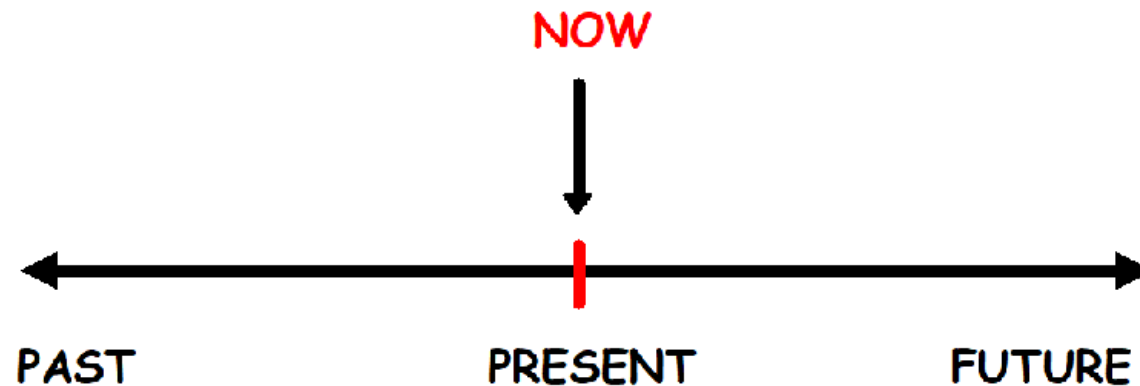
PRESENT NOW - POINT IN TIME

I satisfy my desire for sweets by eating mostly fruit.

You qualify as a physician.

We occupy two buildings downtown.

Farmers supply the food that we need to eat in order to survive.

Simple Future – Example 1 using the word “will” to precede or go before the Root or Base word form AND THE USE OF ADVERBS LIKE: “before, “after,” “later,” “then,” and/or CONJUNCTIONS LIKE “but” to indicate sequence.

Used with ALL Pronouns I, you, she, he, it, we, and they, OR their equivalent.

I will lobby...

You will study...

He will supply...

She will identify...

It will copy...

We will empty...

They will fry...

FUTURE REGULARLY SCHEDULED INCOMPLETE EVENTS

I will lobby for Pro-Life legislation through my regular correspondence.

You will study your spelling words every night before the test.

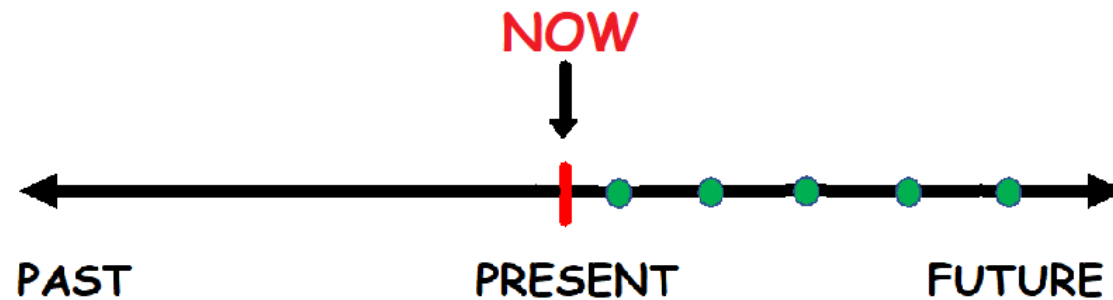
He will supply boxes for our merchandise on a monthly basis.

She will identify fingerprints for the FBI daily.

The new copy machine will copy originals every 3 seconds.

We will empty the trash every Wednesday night.

They will fry french fries as needed throughout the shift.

Simple Future – Example 2 using the word “will” to precede or go before the Root or Base word form AND THE USE OF ADVERBS LIKE: “before, “after,” “later,” “then,” and/or CONJUNCTIONS LIKE “but” to indicate sequence.

Used with ALL Pronouns I, you, she, he, it, we, and they, OR their equivalent.

I will hurry...

You will modify...

He will qualify...

She will fry...

It will certify...

We will justify...

They will notify...

FUTURE - FORWARD TO ONE POINT IN TIME

He will qualify for a position as an electrician once he passes the test.

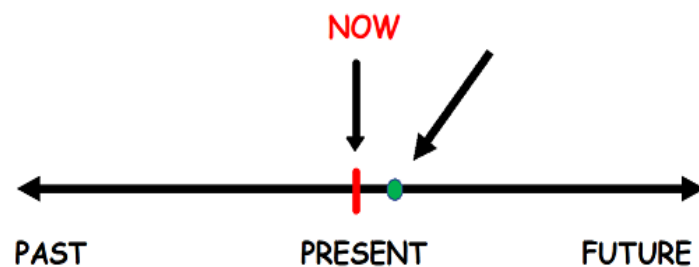
She will fry chicken for dinner tonight.
