SIMPLE PRESENT - EXAMPLE 1

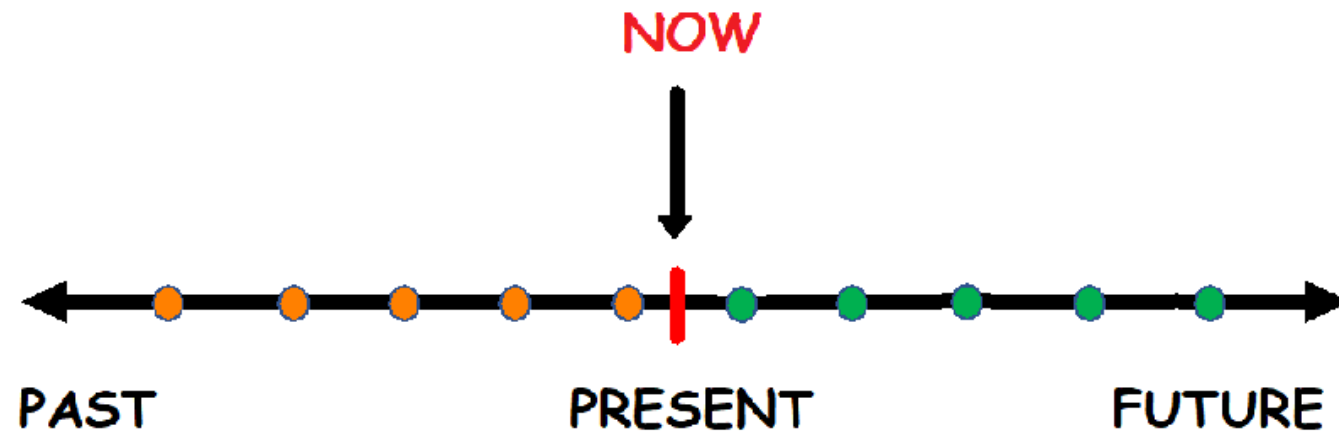
PRESENT REGULARLY SCHEDULED COMPLETED EVENTS

SIMPLE PRESENT - EXAMPLE 2

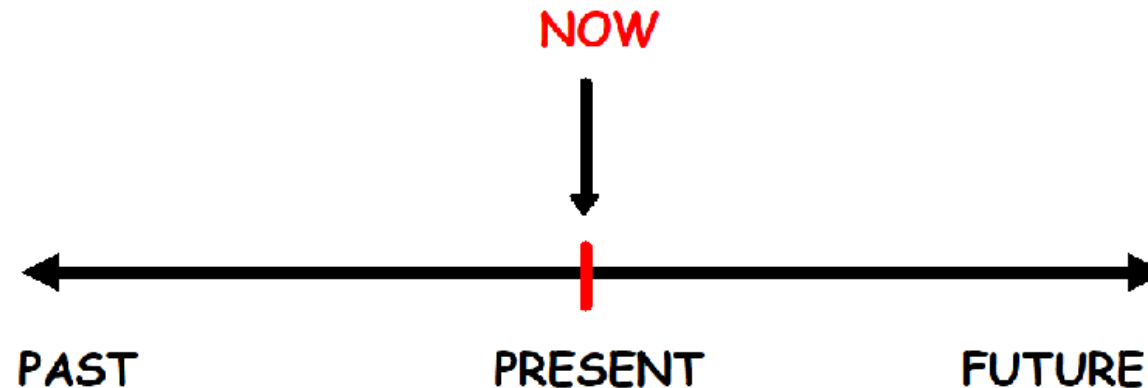
PRESENT NOW - POINT IN TIME

Simple Future – Example 1 using the word “will” to precede or go before the Root or Base word form AND THE USE OF ADVERBS LIKE: “before,” “after,” “later,” “then,” and/or CONJUNCTIONS LIKE “but” to indicate sequence.

Used with ALL Pronouns I, you, she, he, it, we, and they, OR their equivalent.

I will buoy...

You will volley...

He will hay...

She will journey...

It will enjoy...

We will play...

They will pray...

FUTURE REGULARLY SCHEDULED INCOMPLETE EVENTS

At practice each week, you will first volley the ball back and forth for practice with no scoring.

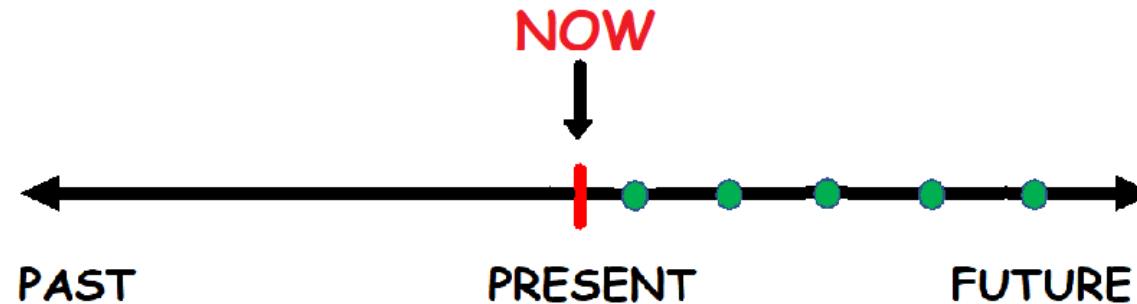
He will hay the horses every morning.

He will journey to Ethiopia in the spring on a missions trip.

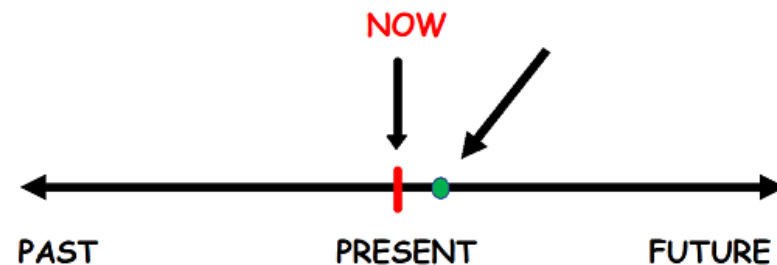
As a gift, she will defray the cost of a student's tuition in the fall.
