You worked overtime for 13 years.

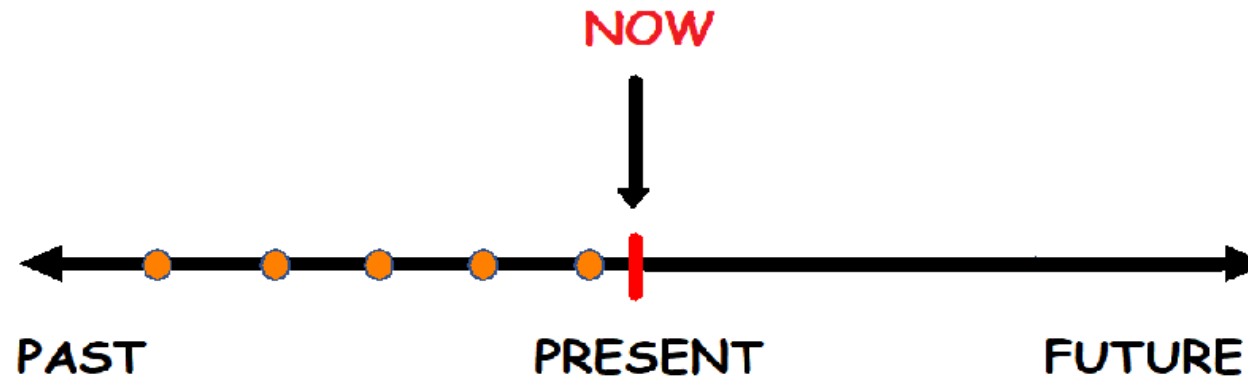
He volunteered weekly at the local food bank.

A year ago, you lifted a rock and found thousands of ants.

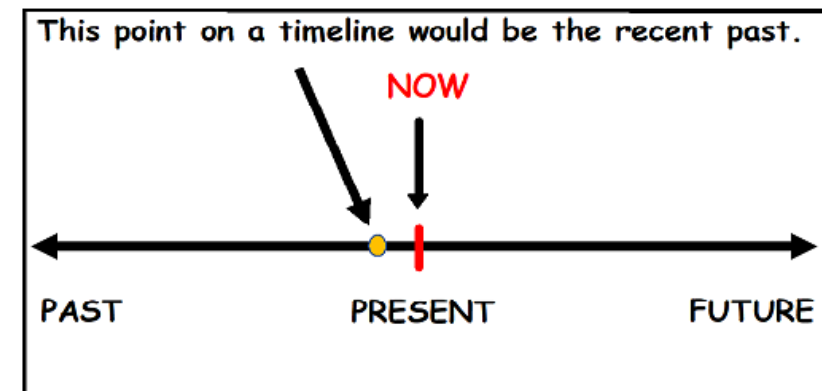
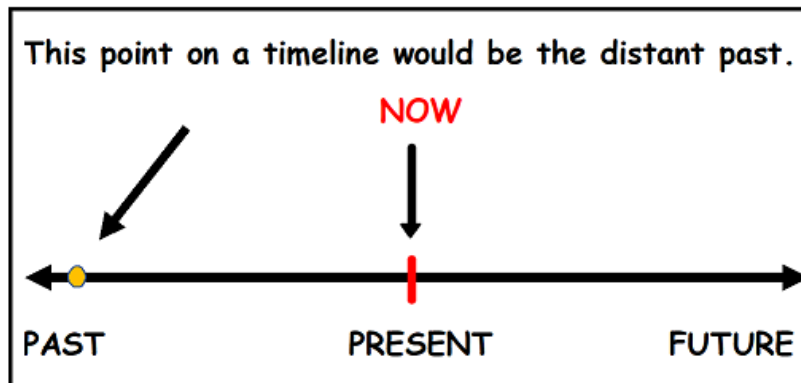
He cleaned the inside of the car today.

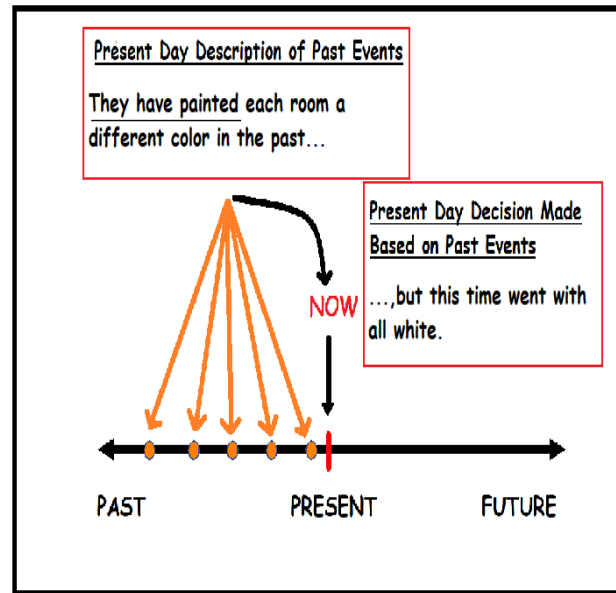

PRESENT PERFECT

PRESENT - 1 OR MORE EVENTS IN THE PAST THAT ARE PERTINENT TO THE PRESENT AND MAY/MAY NOT BE AFFECTING EVENTS HAPPENING IN THE PRESENT



I have toured the Canadian Rockies in the past, but the price of the trip is MUCH higher now.

You have tented in many places in the past, but now you are enjoying a bed to sleep in while on vacation.

He has supported pro-life legislation for many years and continues to do so.

She has planted a vegetable garden for the past 3 years, but now she's planting flowers instead.

The sander has sanded many projects in the past, but today it stopped working.

In the past, we have quieted the baby by taking it for a ride around the block, but it didn't work this time.

You had munched on snacks before we had dinner.

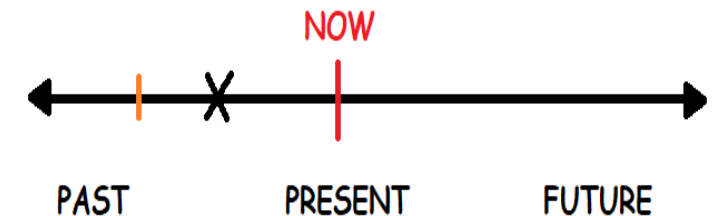
He had missed the ball twice and then got a home run.

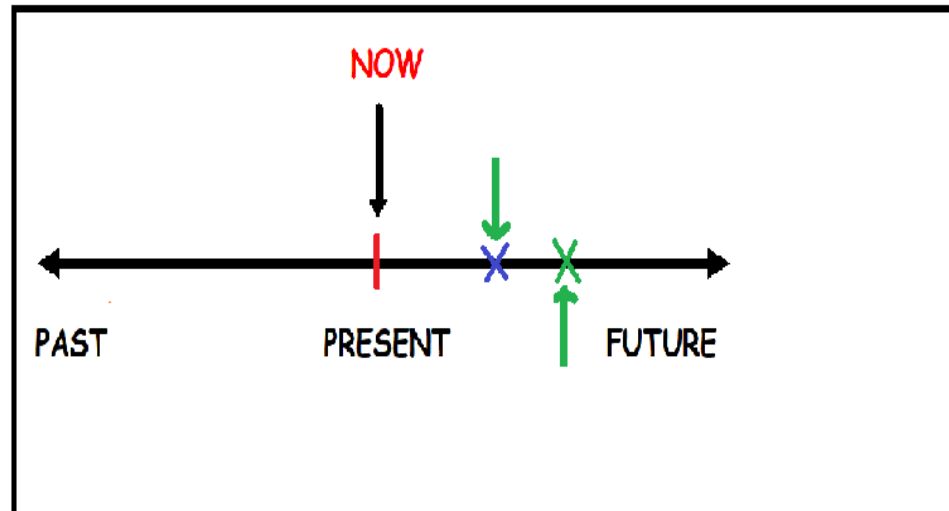

FUTURE - A SENTENCE MAKING A COMPARISON BETWEEN HOW 2 OR MORE SEQUENTIAL EVENTS OCCUR IN A FUTURE TIME FRAME.

I will have repaired the basement floor before next fall.



You will have finished your degree by the time the baby is born.

He will have fixed the roof before the next rainfall.

She will have the meal finished before everyone gets home for dinner.

The project will have reached completion before the estimated date.

We will have cleaned the house before the family arrives.

They will have dumped 2 yards of gravel before the patio is laid.
