One year from now, you will have been dyeing, carding, and weaving wool for 20 years.

This coming New Year's Day, he will have been treating health issues and freeing wild animals for 30 years.

She will have been disagreeing with her colleagues in the House of Representatives for 2 hours before the gavel hits the desk.

The hound will have been treeing the gray fox for hours before his owner gets through the briar patches and thickets to follow him.

We will have been guaranteeing good customer service for 25 years come this autumn.

They will have been eyeing each other lovingly for 50 years come this anniversary.
