




#### PAST - ACTION IN PROGRESS







**PRESENT** - EVENTS THAT START IN THE PAST, ARE STILL OCCURRING, AND COULD CONTINUE, THAT ARE PERTINENT TO PRESENT CONVERSATION

They have been spying on the murder suspect for weeks.



I have been relying on God to help me create good materials and lessons.

You, Lord Jesus have been carrying the weight of this organization.

He has been notifying people that he lost his dog.

She has been certifying new graduates for teacher certification.

The beaver has been hurrying to complete its dam all afternoon.



## PAST PERFECT PROGRESSIVE OR CONTINUOUS

**PAST - 1 CONTINUOUS EVENT THAT IS INTERRUPTED BY ANOTHER EVENT**

They had been justifying their behaviors, but when the judge silenced them they stopped.



I had been trying to get a task done faster, but the Lord gave me an assignment to also evangelize during summer on the weekends.

In the past, you had been relying on help to walk, but when the Lord healed you, you could walk alone!



### FUTURE PERFECT PROGRESSIVE OR CONTINUOUS

FUTURE - ONE EVENT THAT BEGINS IN THE PAST, OR PRESENT THAT CONTINUES INTO THE FUTURE UNTIL ANOTHER EVENT INTERRUPTS IT, A FUTURE DATE BRINGS IT TO COMPLETION, OR A GOAL IS ATTAINED.

They will have been studying Covid 19 for 2 years come January 2022.



The Lord and I will have been supplying lessons and free teaching materials for 4 years come August 2022.

You will have been carrying building materials for 10 hours straight by the time you go off shift.

He will have been copying materials for 10 hours when his replacement finally shows up.

She will have been qualifying and training new employees for 20 years come this New Year.

It will have been tidying its dam for 12 hours once the sun goes down.

We will have been satisfying customers for 30 years come next May.
