What the BIBLE Says About SHOWING CLEAVAGE and PROOF of WHY Women and Men Should Modestly Cover Themselves

When Christian families, schools, churches, businesses, and organizations have given people a dress code, or corrected people for not dressing modestly, many people have FALSELY believed that somehow this was a form of oppression. This IS NOT the case! In fact, it WAS and IS LOVE AND IT WAS GOD GUIDED! The scriptures support modest dress in ALL circumstances!

All of these scriptures apply to BOTH men and women. God DOES NOT show favoritism. (Lev. 19:15, Acts 10:34, Romans, 2:11, Gal. 2:6, Ephesians 6:9, Col. 3:25) Even in the Old Testament there WERE male prostitutes.

Proverbs 5: 1 - 23 New International Version

**“5 My son, pay attention to my wisdom,
turn your ear to my words of insight,
2 that you may maintain discretion
and your lips may preserve knowledge.
3 For the lips of the adulterous woman drip honey,
and her speech is smoother than oil;
4 but in the end she is bitter as gall,
sharp as a double-edged sword.
5 Her feet go down to death;
her steps lead straight to the grave.
6 She gives no thought to the way of life;
her paths wander aimlessly, but she does not know it.**

**7 Now then, my sons, listen to me;
do not turn aside from what I say.**

**8 Keep to a path far from her,
do not go near the door of her house,**

**9 lest you lose your honor to others
and your dignity^[a] to one who is cruel,**

**10 lest strangers feast on your wealth
and your toil enrich the house of another.**

**11 At the end of your life you will groan,
when your flesh and body are spent.**

**12 You will say, “How I hated discipline!
How my heart spurned correction!**

**13 I would not obey my teachers
or turn my ear to my instructors.**

**14 And I was soon in serious trouble
in the assembly of God’s people.”**

Notice how Proverbs 5: 19 – 20 says,

¹⁹ A loving doe, a graceful deer—
may her breasts satisfy you always,
may you ever be intoxicated with her love.

²⁰ Why, my son, be intoxicated with another man’s wife?
Why embrace the bosom of a wayward woman?” (NIV)

If you look up that word “breasts” in that scripture it says:

Strong’s H1717

“dad” (pronounced just like we say it in English)

“breast, nipple, teat” also

apparently from the same as H1730: the breast (as the seat of love, or from its shape):—breast, teat.

If you look up H1730 it says in this context:

“from an unused root meaning properly, to boil, i.e. (figuratively) to love; by implication, a love-token” (Strong’s H1730, BLB, 2022)

So, is the exposing of the breast supposed to be to just anyone? Are you to give or expose a “love token” to just anyone? (BLB, 2022)

No. It is a “love token” only to be shared with your husband. (Strong’s H1730, BLB, 2022)

The Song of Solomon – is a biblical book that represents courtship and a relationship between a husband and wife.

When speaking about love between a husband and wife it deals with romantic love and sexual intimacy in the natural.

It is also a symbol speaking about the Lord Jesus Christ’s relationship with His Bride – the church - in the spiritual and in the natural and cautioning them NOT to form relationships with false Gods.

Three times a similar warning is repeated within the Song of Solomon. This warning is meant for BOTH men and women:

Song of Solomon 2:7 New King James Version

“7 I [a]charge you, O daughters of Jerusalem, By the gazelles or by the does of the field, Do not stir up nor awaken love

Until it pleases.” (NKJV)

Song of Solomon 3:5 New King James Version

**“5 I [b]charge you, O daughters of
Jerusalem, By the gazelles or by the does of
the field, Do not stir up nor awaken love
Until it pleases.” (NKJV)**

Song of Solomon 8:4 New King James Version

**“4 I charge you, O daughters of
Jerusalem, Do not stir up nor awaken
love Until it pleases.” (NKJV)**

**The words: “Do not stir up nor awaken love
Until it pleases.” (Song of Solomon 2:7, 3:5, and 8:4 NKJV) all
mean the same thing:**

**That word “awaken” (NKJV) in all of those verses, means
“`uwr” – pronounced [or with a rolled r] “to arouse
oneself,” “stir up,” or “incite” (Strong’s H5782, BLB,
2019)**

**The word “love” (NKJV) in all of those verses means
“`ahabah” pronounced [ă- have- ah] - love “between man
and woman” or “sexual desire” (Strong’s H160, BLB, 2019)**

**The word “pleases” (NKJV) in all of those verses means
“chaphets” – pronounced [ha - fates] “to delight in,”
“take pleasure in,” or “to be pleased to do” “of God.”
(Strong’s H2654, BLB, 2019)**

So, when you look at those scriptures this is what they say when we replace the words with the definitions:

Do not “arouse oneself,” “stir up,” or “incite” “sexual desire” until it “to be pleased to do” “of God.” (Strong’s H5782, BLB, 2019), (Strong’s H160, BLB, 2019), (Strong’s H2654, BLB, 2019)

When referring to natural romantic love and sexuality between a man and a woman - it warns not to stir up or awaken love and sexuality until it is the right time, meaning when it pleases GOD, and therefore benefits YOU. This means AFTER marriage takes place and it is only to be between a husband and wife. So, exposing one’s breasts is like giving a “love token” to just anyone, which God is totally opposed to. (Strong’s H1730, BLB, 2022)

Proverbs 7:1-18 New International Version

- “7 My son, keep my words
and store up my commands within you.
² Keep my commands and you will live;
guard my teachings as the apple of your eye.
³ Bind them on your fingers;
write them on the tablet of your heart.
⁴ Say to wisdom, “You are my sister,”
and to insight, “You are my relative.”**

⁵ They will keep you from the adulterous woman,
from the wayward woman with her seductive words.

⁶ At the window of my house
I looked down through the lattice.

⁷ I saw among the simple,
I noticed among the young men,
a youth who had no sense.

⁸ He was going down the street near her corner,
walking along in the direction of her house

⁹ at twilight, as the day was fading,
as the dark of night set in.

¹⁰ Then out came a woman to meet him,
dressed like a prostitute and with crafty intent.

¹¹ (She is unruly and defiant,
her feet never stay at home;

¹² now in the street, now in the squares,
at every corner she lurks.)

¹³ She took hold of him and kissed him
and with a brazen face she said:

¹⁴ "Today I fulfilled my vows,
and I have food from my fellowship offering at home.

¹⁵ So I came out to meet you;
I looked for you and have found you!

¹⁶ I have covered my bed
with colored linens from Egypt.

¹⁷ I have perfumed my bed
with myrrh, aloes and cinnamon.

¹⁸ Come, let's drink deeply of love till morning;
let's enjoy ourselves with love!" (NIV)

LET'S BE HONEST, we ALL KNOW HOW a prostitute dresses, whether she is doing it as an act of HER OWN WILL OR AS AN ACT AGAINST HER OWN WILL IN THE CASE OF HUMAN SEX TRAFFICKING. Either way, it is a form of bondage. In the first case, HER OWN WILL - she is in bondage to Satan through SIN and she CHOOSES to dress immodestly HERSELF. It's the SAME AS PROSTITUTION TO GOD. This can also include CHOOSING to dance naked or almost naked in a night club/ dance hall, or working in a Playboy club, topless restaurant, or a restaurant that wants her to bare cleavage for pay. It also includes those in the modeling, television, and movie industry who do the same things.

God said,

1 Timothy 6:9-10 New International Version

“⁹ Those who want to get rich fall into temptation and a trap and into many foolish and harmful desires that plunge people into ruin and destruction. ¹⁰ For the love of money is a root of all kinds of evil. Some people, eager for money, have wandered from the faith and pierced themselves with many griefs.” (NIV)

In the second case, she is in bondage to a pimp and she is a VICTIM NOT OF HER OWN MAKING. Prostitutes are enslaved and ordered to bare their cleavage to entice men. They wear short-shorts, sheer garments, short skirts and dresses, and garments so tight that they leave nothing to the imagination and show every part of their bodies.

God EXPECTS parents to teach their children to dress modestly, to PROTECT their daughters, so they are NEVER made prostitutes by someone else, to NEVER make their daughters a prostitute by selling their own children, and to PREVENT them from turning to prostitution themselves.

Leviticus 19:29 New International Version

“²⁹“Do not degrade your daughter by making her a prostitute, or the land will turn to prostitution and be filled with wickedness.” (NIV)

In the Old Testament and in the NEW Testament, God equates immodest dress, prostitution, and sexual immorality, as ALL being the SAME thing and it is also idolatry, because it is TOTAL REBELLION to the Lord. The following scriptures use prostitution and sexual immorality as an example of idolatry.

Ezekiel 23: 1 – 49 New International Version

““²³ The word of the LORD came to me: ²“Son of man, there were two women, daughters of the same mother. ³They became prostitutes in Egypt, engaging in prostitution from their youth. In that land their breasts were fondled and their virgin bosoms caressed. ⁴The older was named Oholah, and her sister was Oholibah. They were mine and gave birth to sons and daughters. Oholah is Samaria, and Oholibah is Jerusalem.

⁵“Oholah engaged in prostitution while she was still mine; and she lusted after her lovers, the Assyrians—warriors ⁶ clothed in blue, governors and commanders, all of them handsome young men, and mounted horsemen. ⁷ She gave herself as a prostitute to all the elite of the Assyrians and defiled herself with all the idols of everyone she lusted after. ⁸ She did not give up the prostitution she began in Egypt, when during her youth men slept with her, caressed her virgin bosom and poured out their lust on her.

⁹“Therefore I delivered her into the hands of her lovers, the Assyrians, for whom she lusted. ¹⁰ They stripped her naked, took away her sons and daughters and killed her with the sword. She became a byword among women, and punishment was inflicted on her.

¹¹ “Her sister Oholibah saw this, yet in her lust and prostitution she was more depraved than her sister. ¹² She too lusted after the Assyrians—governors and commanders, warriors in full dress, mounted horsemen, all handsome young men. ¹³ I saw that she too defiled herself; both of them went the same way.

¹⁴ “But she carried her prostitution still further. She saw men portrayed on a wall, figures of Chaldeans^[a] portrayed in red, ¹⁵ with belts around their waists and flowing turbans on their heads; all of them looked like Babylonian chariot officers, natives of Chaldea.^[b] ¹⁶ As soon as she saw them, she lusted after them and sent messengers to them in Chaldea. ¹⁷ Then the Babylonians came to her, to the bed of love, and in their lust they defiled her. After she had been defiled by them, she turned away from them in disgust. ¹⁸ When she carried on her prostitution openly and exposed her naked body, I turned away from her in disgust, just as I had turned away from her sister. ¹⁹ Yet she became more and more promiscuous as she recalled the days of her youth, when she was a prostitute in Egypt. ²⁰ There she lusted after her lovers, whose genitals were like those of donkeys and whose emission was like that of horses. ²¹ So you longed for the lewdness of your youth, when in Egypt your bosom was caressed and your young breasts fondled.^[c]

²² “Therefore, Oholibah, this is what the Sovereign LORD says: I will stir up your lovers against you, those you turned away from in disgust, and I will bring them against you from every side— ²³ the Babylonians and all the Chaldeans, the men of Pekod and Shoa and Koa, and all the Assyrians with them, handsome young men, all of them governors and commanders, chariot officers and men of high rank, all mounted on horses. ²⁴ They will come against you with weapons,^[d] chariots and wagons and with a throng of people; they will take up positions against you on every side with large and small shields and with helmets. I will turn you over to them for punishment, and they will punish you according to their standards. ²⁵ I will direct my jealous anger against you, and they will deal with you in fury. They will cut off your noses and your ears, and those of you who are left will fall by the sword. They will take away your sons and daughters, and

those of you who are left will be consumed by fire. ²⁶ They will also strip you of your clothes and take your fine jewelry. ²⁷ So I will put a stop to the lewdness and prostitution you began in Egypt. You will not look on these things with longing or remember Egypt anymore.

²⁸ “For this is what the Sovereign LORD says: I am about to deliver you into the hands of those you hate, to those you turned away from in disgust. ²⁹ They will deal with you in hatred and take away everything you have worked for. They will leave you stark naked, and the shame of your prostitution will be exposed. Your lewdness and promiscuity ³⁰ have brought this on you, because you lusted after the nations and defiled yourself with their idols. ³¹ You have gone the way of your sister; so I will put her cup into your hand.

³² “This is what the Sovereign LORD says:

“You will drink your sister’s cup,
a cup large and deep;
it will bring scorn and derision,
for it holds so much.

³³ You will be filled with drunkenness and sorrow,
the cup of ruin and desolation,
the cup of your sister Samaria.

³⁴ You will drink it and drain it dry
and chew on its pieces—
and you will tear your breasts.

I have spoken, declares the Sovereign LORD.

³⁵ “Therefore this is what the Sovereign LORD says: Since you have forgotten me and turned your back on me, you must bear the consequences of your lewdness and prostitution.”

³⁶ The LORD said to me: “Son of man, will you judge Oholah and Oholibah? **Then confront them with their detestable practices,** ³⁷ **for they have committed adultery and blood is on their hands. They committed adultery with their idols; they even sacrificed their children, whom they bore to me, as food for them.** ³⁸ **They have also done this to me: At that same time they defiled my sanctuary and desecrated my Sabbaths.** ³⁹ **On the very day they sacrificed their children to their idols, they entered my sanctuary and desecrated it. That is what they did in my house.**

⁴⁰ “They even sent messengers for men who came from far away, and when they arrived you bathed yourself for them, applied eye makeup and put on your jewelry. ⁴¹ You sat on an elegant couch, with a table spread before it on which you had placed the incense and olive oil that belonged to me.

⁴² “The noise of a carefree crowd was around her; drunkards were brought from the desert along with men from the rabble, and they put bracelets on the wrists of the woman and her sister and beautiful crowns on their heads. ⁴³ Then I said about the one worn out by adultery, ‘Now let them use her as a prostitute, for that is all she is.’ ⁴⁴ And they slept with her. As men sleep with a prostitute, so they slept with those lewd women, Oholah and Oholibah. ⁴⁵ But righteous judges will sentence them to the punishment of women who commit adultery and shed blood, because they are adulterous and blood is on their hands.

⁴⁶ “This is what the Sovereign LORD says: Bring a mob against them and give them over to terror and plunder. ⁴⁷ The mob will stone them and cut them down with their swords; they will kill their sons and daughters and burn down their houses.

⁴⁸ **“So I will put an end to lewdness in the land, that all women may take warning and not imitate you. ⁴⁹ You will suffer the penalty for your lewdness and bear the consequences of your sins of idolatry. Then you will know that I am the Sovereign LORD.”” (NIV)**

In the NEW Testament Christ said,

Matthew 5:27-30 New American Standard Bible

“27 “You have heard that it was said, ‘YOU SHALL NOT COMMIT ADULTERY’; 28 but I say to you that everyone who looks at a woman with lust for her has already committed adultery with her in his heart.

29 If your right eye makes you [a]stumble, tear it out and throw it from you; for it is better for you [b]to lose one of the parts of your body, [c]than for your whole body to be thrown into [d]hell. 30 If your right hand makes you [e]stumble, cut it off and throw it from you; for it is better for you [f]to lose one of the parts of your body, [g]than for your whole body to go into [h]hell.”
(NASB)

Now, a woman/man who is immodestly dressed IS creating that temptation and ALSO committing adultery using someone else's eyes to do so and creating pornography. YES, it is true! It can be any person male or female. If you also kiss someone or touch someone other than your husband or wife in an unGodly fashion – you have committed adultery in the eyes of God.

In the New Testament it also says in:

1 Corinthians 6:14-16 New International Version

“¹⁴ By his power God raised the Lord from the dead, and he will raise us also. ¹⁵ Do you not know that your bodies are members of Christ himself? Shall I then take the members of Christ and unite them with a prostitute? Never! ¹⁶ Do you not know that he who unites himself with a prostitute is one with her in body? For it is said, “The two will become one flesh.”^[a]” (NIV)

**That word “prostitute” (NIV) in the Hebrew it means:
“pornē” pronounced [par- nay] (Strong’s G4204, BLB,
2019)**

I. “A woman who sells her body for sexual uses”

A. “a prostitute, a harlot, one who yields herself to defilement for the sake of gain”

B. “any woman indulging in unlawful sexual intercourse, whether for gain or for lust”

II. “metaph. an idolatress”

A. “of "Babylon" i.e. Rome, the chief seat of idolatry” (Strong’s G4204, BLB, 2019)

“unlawful” in that definition means against God’s law. (Strong’s G4204, BLB, 2019)

Notice how that word prostitute/harlot is a derivative of the word porn and a prostitute/harlot (whether male or female) doesn’t have to do it for money. He/she can do it for “gain” and for “lust.” (Strong’s, G4204, BLB, 2019) That word “unlawful” sexual intercourse means against GOD’S law. (Strong’s, G4204, BLB, 2019) That means if you have

sexual relationships outside the bonds of marriage you ARE a prostitute/harlot in God's eyes whether you stand on a street corner and sell yourself for money or not. That's what whoredom is. If you are involved in, participating in creating, or being used for PORN you are ALSO participating in sexual immorality. Dressing immodestly is ALSO creating PORN!

Romans 13:9-10 New American Standard Bible

"9 For this, "YOU SHALL NOT COMMIT ADULTERY, YOU SHALL NOT MURDER, YOU SHALL NOT STEAL, YOU SHALL NOT COVET," and if there is any other commandment, it is summed up in this saying, "YOU SHALL LOVE YOUR NEIGHBOR AS YOURSELF." 10 Love [a]does no wrong to a neighbor; therefore love is the fulfillment of the law." (NASB)

So, if you dress immodestly are you doing wrong to your neighbor? YES, you are – GREAT HARM. Unrepentant immodesty which leads someone else's eyes to adultery or whoredom is also a sin.

Coming to Christ requires a CHANGE in your lifestyle. Anyone who tells you differently is lying to you. Don't listen to the voices of the false prophets who say you can stay the same and remain a part of His church. Dressing immodestly, is no different than you being a pole dancer at a STRIP club. Husbands are WRONG in allowing it too!

Wearing a blouse that shows cleavage or is open down to the waist is hypocrisy and sin. Wearing a dress with a bare back down to the top of the buttocks is hypocrisy and sin and that includes for wedding gowns. Wrapping your legs around a man in an unGodly fashion in public through dance whether it is your husband or someone else is hypocrisy and sin.

People in the entertainment industry are some of the worst offenders. Young women who are cheerleaders at football games and entertainers with their half-time programs are dressing in immodest outfits which is the same as pornography - enticing men and women into sin.

Many nursing mothers think that they don't have to nurse in a modest way, but you do. No, you don't have to go to the bathroom to do it, all you need is a light sheet or blanket to throw across your shoulder while you nurse. I did it myself in restaurants and everywhere and people never knew that I was nursing my baby.

The same rules for immodesty apply to men. In the New Testament, in the book of John, Chapter 21, the Lord Jesus came to the shore near where the disciples were fishing, but the men didn't realize it was Christ who was there. The Apostle Peter was caught naked while fishing. As soon as he was aware that it was Christ on the shore, he jumped into the water in embarrassment knowing he was doing something wrong.

John 21: 2 - 8 King James Version

"2 There were together Simon Peter, and Thomas called Didymus, and Nathanael of Cana in Galilee, and the sons of Zebedee, and two other of his disciples.

3 Simon Peter saith unto them, I go a fishing. They say unto him, We also go with thee. They went forth, and entered into a ship immediately; and that night they caught nothing.

4 But when the morning was now come, Jesus stood on the shore: but the disciples knew not that it was Jesus.

5 Then Jesus saith unto them, Children, have ye any meat? They answered him, No.

6 And he said unto them, Cast the net on the right side of the ship, and ye shall find. They cast therefore, and now they were not able to draw it for the multitude of fishes.

7 Therefore that disciple whom Jesus loved saith unto Peter, It is the Lord. Now when Simon Peter heard that it was the Lord, he girt his fisher's coat unto him, (for he was naked,) and did cast himself into the sea.

8 And the other disciples came in a little ship; (for they were not far from land, but as it were two hundred cubits,) dragging the net with fishes.” (KJV)

Men who expose their muscles and bodies for everyone to see are also practicing immodesty and narcissism too. Wearing a T-shirt when swimming and long swim trunks down to the knee are more appropriate. For women, the Lord prefers a modest top with no cleavage showing and long swim bottoms down to the knee for women too. The Lord does NOT approve of short-shorts for women. God is calling Godly designers who will design Godly modest clothing and appropriate swim-suits for women and men now.

If you view others who are immodestly dressed in television, movies, plays, and the internet, if you buy clothing for yourself or others that promotes immodesty, if you manufacture immodest clothing, sell it, or invest in it, if you use or film immodest clothing in television, movies, films, and plays as an actor or actress, model, director, producer, or camera person – you are in sin.

What is even MORE damaging is the fact that Christians are modeling to other

people that these behaviors are okay. These are sins – they are NOT okay!

1 Thessalonians 4:1-8 New King James Version

“4 Finally then, brethren, we urge and exhort in the Lord Jesus that you should abound more and more, just as you received from us how you ought to walk and to please God;

2 for you know what commandments we gave you through the Lord Jesus.

3 For this is the will of God, your sanctification: that you should abstain from sexual immorality;

4 that each of you should know how to possess his own vessel in sanctification and honor,

5 not in passion of lust, like the Gentiles who do not know God;

6 that no one should take advantage of and defraud his brother in this matter, because the Lord is the avenger of all such, as we also forewarned you and testified.

7 For God did not call us to uncleanness, but in holiness.

8 Therefore he who rejects this does not reject man, but God, who has also given[a] us His Holy Spirit.” (NKJV)

So, if you are willingly showing cleavage and dressing in an immodest way - you are in sin too, because you are creating your own pornography. It is a form of enticement and delivers a message to the viewer that you are an easy sexual target. If you don't want to be viewed or thought of as a whore, then stop advertising yourself as one and instead dress modestly. Immodesty IS a form of whoredom.

Leviticus 19:29 New International Version

“²⁹ “Do not degrade your daughter by making her a prostitute, or the land will turn to prostitution and be filled with wickedness.” (NIV)

I gave you this scripture earlier in regards to a parent's responsibility, but every person has a responsibility to be a good steward of their OWN bodies and MODEST DRESS IS REQUIRED, BECAUSE YOU CAN DEGRADE YOURSELF!

The Lord wrote this poem in 2016 which I had recorded and sent out into the world:

Christians, we have a dress code and here is why,

Lord Jesus Christ said you could commit adultery

even with the eye.

Ladies, no cleavage should be showing, no plunging necklines to the waist

that make it look to the beholder that you put nothing on in haste.

Lower hemlines you possess. Cover slits that go too high.

Don't dress in underwear for every passer-by.

No G strings and no bikinis,

just in case you had the thought. God wants to warn you,

BEFORE they have been bought.

Men, you are no exception. Expose much less.
