



Pap, meaning, my Grandpa, is a funny old chap.




He, my Dad, and I, like to hike trails and we take a map.

"Make sure they know how long you expect to be gone to avoid mishap."




"Just before you leave, check with the park for recent weather updates, road closures, or construction and animal activity.


These are things that every hiker considers a necessity."




"Know your physical limits and know what you will do in the event of an emergency."




"You can't count on cell phone service, so having basic survival skills and traveling with others can be an absolute necessity."




"Don't be a sap, hike with a group of at least 3 or more. There is safety in numbers as you explore."




"Have a first aid kit, sun protection, water, and food for nutrition."




"Have special supplies for an emergency and tools for navigation."




"Stay on the trail, it's safer for you. Walk single file to make room for others too."




"If you want to pass someone from behind, be friendly, and calmly tell them so."

"Yield to OTHERS climbing UP a hill too, because if you're going down - it is easier for YOU."




"If you are riding a bike, you need to STOP and let hikers, horses, and other pack animals go first. After all, you are on a vehicle that can make quicker speed bursts."






We hear branches snap as we walk. We whisper as we talk.




We WANT to hear and see birds chirp...

We want to see and hear beavers use their tails and slap.




We want to hear and see chipmunks with their chitter chatter and yap.

Pap says, "In bear country, it's different, you need to be EVEN MORE ALERT, take pepper spray, and make more noise so they can hear you approaching."




"No need to take chances, after all, it's THEIR habitat where WE are encroaching."

"If you don't, it COULD MEAN YOUR LIFE FOREVERMORE!"




"We don't feed or approach wild animals," he says, "It's not nature's way."
