"14 "The days are coming,' declares the Lord, 'when I will fulfill the good promise I made to the people of Israel and Judah.

15 "In those days and at that time I will make a righteous Branch sprout from David's line;

he will do what is just and right in the land.

16 In those days Judah will be saved and Jerusalem will live in safety.

This is the name by which it[a] will be called: The Lord Our Righteous Savior.'" (NIV)

Elizabeth is in seclusion for 5 Months including the first one. Luke 1: 24 "24 After this his wife Elizabeth became pregnant and for five months remained in seclusion." NIV

We use scriptural references and God's prophetic words to determine approximate time references and base them on estimated conceptions that are made at the beginning of the month.

Elizabeth Conceives

Luke 1: 24 - 25

"24 After this his wife Elizabeth became pregnant and for five months remained in seclusion. 25 "The Lord has done this for me," she said. "In these days he has shown his favor and taken away my disgrace among the people.'" (NIV)

In Luke 1: 26-38 It is the 6th month of the year. The angel Gabriel visits the virgin Mary and tells her she will conceive a Son through the Holy Spirit.

His name will be Jesus - Son of God. He tells her that Elizabeth is bearing a son as well, and that she is in the 6th month of her pregnancy.

This is the 7th Month of Elizabeth's pregnancy & the 2nd Month of Mary's pregnancy.

This is the 8th Month of Elizabeth's pregnancy & the 3rd Month of Mary's pregnancy.

Luke 1:56 "56 Mary stayed with Elizabeth for about three months and then returned home." (NIV)

In Luke 1: 57- 79 John the Baptist is born. He is circumcised, named, and prophesied over.

This is the 4th Month of Mary's Pregnancy.

Isaiah 11 : 1 - 5 New International Version

"11 A shoot will come up from the stump of Jesse; from his roots a Branch will bear fruit. 2 The Spirit of the Lord will rest on him— the Spirit of wisdom and of understanding, the Spirit of counsel and of might, the Spirit of the knowledge and fear of the Lord— 3 and he will delight in the fear of the Lord.

He will not judge by what he sees with his eyes, or decide by what he hears with his ears; 4 but with righteousness he will judge the needy, with justice he will give decisions for the poor of the earth. He will strike the earth with the rod of his mouth; with the breath of his lips he will slay the wicked. 5 Righteousness will be his belt and faithfulness the sash around his waist." (NIV)
