

The word FERRY can refer to a boat or ship used to carry not only people, but also their cars from one land mass to another. It can also mean to TRANSPORT anywhere, by any possible means: by air, truck, boat, car, etc. This book uses the term "ferry" to refer to transporting by a small boat. The man in our illustration is ferrying or transporting blueberries to a new location.

In the past, wooden logs were tied together to make rafts used by "ferrymen" to help people, their horses, and their belongings cross from one side of a river to another. The ferrymen used a long pole to push the raft across the river. Those rafts, were also referred to as a "ferries."

Now, ferries (plural form) can be used to transport only a small number of people and their vehicles or a larger amount. Large ferries are large boats or ships that can hold even over 100 cars and the people who drive them. On the following pages you will see some photos of different types of ferries used today to transport BOTH people and their cars to a new land location by way of a ferry boat/ship.

Boats that are used to carry small numbers of people from one land mass to another WITHOUT their cars are often called "water taxis."

This is an example of a small ferry that can carry people and about 2 to 4 vehicles (depending on their size) from one side of a river to another.


This is an example of a large ferry that can carry both people and cars from one land mass to another. One Canadian ferry that crosses from Vancouver, Canada to Victoria, Canada can hold approximately 115 vehicles.




Some ferries have multiple decks for cars, trucks, and buses. This is what it looks like on the top deck of the ferry that crosses Lake Champlain from New York to Vermont. It holds approximately 50 cars plus the people that drive them. It is approximately a one-hour trip. You can see that it has lifeboats just like any other ship. Some ferries have lounges and places for people to eat too.
