In the Bible, the Hebrew Calendar months are determined by the moon. Moon months can be about 29 or 30 days.

THE FIRST MONTH OF THE HEBREW CALENDAR IS THE MONTH ABIB (pronounced "Aveeve") IT IS THE SAME MONTH AS PASSOVER – THE SAME MONTH CHRIST WAS CRUCIFIED, DIED, AND RESURRECTED.

Exodus 12: 1-11 New International Version

"12 The LORD said to Moses and Aaron in Egypt, ²"This month is to be for you the first month, the first month of your year. ³Tell the whole community of Israel that on the tenth day of this month each man is to take a lamb^[a] for his family, one for each household. ⁴If any household is too small for a whole lamb, they must share one with their nearest neighbor, having taken into account the number of people there are. You are to determine the amount of lamb needed in accordance with what each person will eat. ⁵The animals you choose must be year-old males without defect, and you may take them from the sheep or the goats. ⁶Take care of them until the fourteenth day of the month, when all the members of the community of Israel must slaughter them at twilight. ⁷Then they are to take some of the blood and put it on the sides and tops of the doorframes of the houses where they eat the lambs. ⁸That same night they are to eat the meat roasted over the fire, along with bitter herbs, and bread made without yeast. ⁹Do not eat the meat raw or boiled in water, but roast it over a fire—with the head, legs and internal organs. ¹⁰Do not leave any of it till morning; if some is left till morning, you must burn it. ¹¹This is how you are to eat it: with your cloak tucked into your belt, your sandals on your feet and your staff in your hand. Eat it in haste; it is the LORD's Passover." (NIV)

Deuteronomy 16:1-3 New International Version

"16 Observe the month of Aviv and celebrate the Passover of the LORD your God, because in the month of Aviv he brought you out of Egypt by night. ²Sacrifice as the Passover to the LORD your God an animal from your flock or herd at the place the LORD will choose as a dwelling for his Name. ³Do not eat it with bread made with yeast, but for seven days eat unleavened bread, the bread of affliction, because you left Egypt in haste—so that all the days of your life you may remember the time of your departure from Egypt." (NIV)

It means:

“I. fresh, young barley ears, barley

II. month of ear-forming, of greening of crop, of growing green Abib, month of exodus and passover (sic) (March or April)”

**THE SECOND MONTH IS THE MONTH “ZIV.” (Pronounced exactly as it looks.)
IT IS THE MONTH THAT CHRIST WAS BORN.**

It means:

“Zif = "brightness"

1.name of the 2nd month of the year, corresponding to Apr-May”

THE THIRD MONTH IS THE MONTH “SIVAN,” (Pronounced See-von).

IT IS THE MONTH THE BAPTISM OF THE HOLY SPIRIT WAS GIVEN TO ALL HUMANKIND.

It means:

“I. Sivan = "their covering"

1.the 3rd month in the Jewish calendar corresponding to May-Jun”
