When you look up a word in a dictionary, you will find many words. You will **ALSO** find that even **ONE** word can be a member of several different Parts of Speech depending on how it is used in a sentence. As you read this book, you may find words listed as one form of speech and it also may be listed as another Part of Speech in another context. This **IS NOT** an error. I could not give all of the possible definitions for every word or this book would be hundreds of pages long. Please consult a dictionary if needed.

Interjections

The word "Interject" means to interrupt or to "add in between something else." An **Interjection** is a word, phrase, or utterance that is added to a text to express an emotion. These are words like:

"Hallelujah! Thank you, Lord!"

"Praise God! That was a miracle!"

"Awesome! What a great testimony!"

"Brrr, it's freezing out there!"

"Dear me, I think I cracked my knee!"

"Oh dear, I lost my keys!"

"Eek, there's a mouse in the trap and I
AM NOT TOUCHING IT!"

"Great! I'll see you at 3:00!"

"Heavens, you could have gotten killed!"

"Hey, was that a wonderful song or
what?"

"How sweet, he sent me a dozen roses!"

"Huh, you've got to be kidding?"

"Oh, what a beautiful day it is!"

"Ouch, I got a splinter in my finger."

"Ugh, now the dog has tracked mud all through the house."

"Uh-oh, I see red flashing lights."

"Hmmm, I wonder what color I should paint the living room walls?"

"Mmmm... just what I needed after a long hard day - a soaking bath."

"Whaa! Whoo! I did it!"

"Well, it's time for me to go to bed."

"Wow, I can't believe you did that!"

"Oh brother, now I've really made a mess!"

One form of "Interjection" that no one should ever use is Profanity. Profanity is using words that have an EVIL power attached to them. They are used in anger, they are used while abuse is taking place, they are used as a form of filth. They create a picture in the mind of the hearer. Profanity IS VERBAL PORNOGRAPHY and the unrepentant use of it is abusive and it is a sin.

The Lord's word is clear on this:

Colossians 3:5 - 17 New International Version

"⁵ Put to death, therefore, whatever belongs to your earthly nature: sexual immorality, impurity, lust, evil desires and greed, which is idolatry. ⁶ Because of these, the wrath of God is coming.^[b] ⁷ You used to walk in these ways, in the life you once lived. ⁸ But now you must also rid yourselves of all such things as these: anger, rage, malice, slander, and filthy language from your lips. ⁹ Do not lie to each other, since you have taken off your old self with its practices ¹⁰ and have put on the new self, which is being renewed in knowledge in the image of its Creator.

11 Here there is no Gentile or Jew, circumcised or uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave or free, but Christ is all, and is in all.

12 Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience. **13** Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you. **14** And over all these virtues put on love, which binds them all together in perfect unity.

15 Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace. And be thankful. **16** Let the message of Christ dwell among you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom through psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit, singing to God with gratitude in your hearts. **17** And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him." (NIV)

Ephesians 5:3-6 New International Version

"3 But among you there must not be even a hint of sexual immorality, or of any kind of impurity, or of greed, because these are improper for God's holy people. 4 Nor should there be obscenity, foolish talk or coarse joking, which are out of place, but rather thanksgiving. 5 For of this you can be sure: No immoral, impure or greedy person—such a person is an idolater—has any inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and of God.[a] 6 Let no one deceive you with empty words, for because of such things God's wrath comes on those who are disobedient." (NIV)

"23 For if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like a man observing his natural face in a mirror; 24 for he observes himself, goes away, and immediately forgets what kind of man he was. 25 But he who looks into the perfect law of liberty and continues *in it*, and is not a forgetful hearer but a doer of the work, this one will be blessed in what he does. 26 If anyone [a]among you thinks he is religious, and does not bridle his tongue but deceives his own heart, this one's religion is useless." (NKJV)

Galatians 5:19 - 26 New International Version

"19 The acts of the flesh are obvious: sexual immorality, impurity and debauchery; 20 idolatry and witchcraft; hatred, discord, jealousy, fits of rage, selfish ambition, dissensions, factions 21 and envy; drunkenness, orgies, and the like. I warn you, as I did before, that those who live like this will not inherit the kingdom of God.

22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23 gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law. 24 Those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. 25 Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit. 26 Let us not become conceited, provoking and envying each other." (NIV)

"10 from the same mouth come both blessing and cursing. My brethren, these things ought not to be this way." (NASB)

"3 Therefore I make known to you that no one speaking [a]by the Spirit of God says, "Jesus is [b]accursed"; and no one can say, "Jesus is Lord," except [c]by the Holy Spirit." (NASB)
