WHO ARE THE SAINTS?

**ALL BELIEVERS IN CHRIST – BOTH MEN AND WOMEN. GOD MAKES NO
DIFFERENTIATION.**

1 Peter 2: 1 – 10 New King James Version

2 Therefore, laying aside all malice, all deceit, hypocrisy, envy, and all evil speaking, ² as newborn babes, desire the pure milk of the word, that you may grow ^[a]thereby, ³ if indeed you have tasted that the Lord *is* gracious.

⁴ Coming to Him *as to* a living stone, rejected indeed by men, **but chosen by God *and* precious, ⁵ you also, as living stones, are being built up a spiritual house, a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ. ⁶ Therefore it is also contained in the Scripture,**

**“Behold, I lay in Zion
A chief cornerstone, elect, precious,
And he who believes on Him will by no means be put to shame.”**

⁷ Therefore, to you who believe, *He is* precious; but to those who ^[b]are disobedient,

**“The stone which the builders rejected
Has become the chief cornerstone,”**

⁸ and

**“A stone of stumbling
And a rock of offense.”**

They stumble, being disobedient to the word, to which they also were appointed.

⁹ But you *are* a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light; ¹⁰ who once *were* not a people but *are* now the people of God, who had not obtained mercy but now have obtained mercy.” (NKJV)

YOU TO NEED TO KNOW THE TRUTH CONCERNING THE ORIGINAL TEXT ABOUT WOMEN IN MINISTRY AS WELL!

Junia WAS a woman Apostle the original text says so:

Romans 16:7 INTERLINEAR

“Greet Andronicus and Junias, kinsmen of me and fellow prisoners with me, who are of note among the apostles, who also before me were in Christ.” (INT)

“7 Greet Andronicus and Junia, my fellow Jews who have been in prison with me. They are outstanding among[d] the apostles, and they were in Christ BEFORE I WAS.” (NIV)

WOMEN ARE ALLOWED AS LEADERS IN THE 5-FOLD MINISTRY.

IN THE BOOK OF REVELATION, 5 OUT OF 7 CHURCHES NEED TO BE CORRECTED. THAT MEANS 71% OF THE CHURCHES NEED TO BE CORRECTED AND ARE OUT OF ALIGNMENT WITH GOD.

IF 5 OUT OF 7 CHURCHES ARE OUT OF ALIGNMENT, THEN HOW DID THEY GET THAT WAY, WITH MEN HAVING BEEN PREDOMINATELY THE LEADERS?

GOD WILL AND CAN DEFEND THE WOMEN HE TRULY CALLS INTO MINISTRY!

In ancient society prejudices against women existed in society. YES, even in the churches and even amongst the apostles. We see this several times in the scriptures amongst MEN AND THE APOSTLES THEMSELVES, but what did Christ model and teach?

God does not show favoritism, and it says so in scripture.

Acts 10: 34 - 35

“³⁴ Then Peter opened *his* mouth and said: “In truth I perceive that God shows no partiality. ³⁵ But in every nation whoever fears Him and works righteousness is accepted by Him.” (NKJV)

IN LUKE 7: 36 – 50 A PHARISEE INVITED CHRIST TO EAT WITH HIM ALONG WITH OTHERS. THE HOST, A MAN NAMED SIMON, IS GENTLY BUT PURPOSELY REBUKED BY CHRIST FOR HIS PREJUDICE AGAINST A WOMAN, BECAUSE BY CHRIST’S JUDGMENT AND IN CHRIST’S EYES SHE WAS, LIKE THE MEN, – A FORGIVEN FORMER SINNER.

Luke 7: 36 – 50 New King James Version

“³⁶ Then one of the Pharisees asked Him to eat with him. And He went to the Pharisee’s house, and sat down to eat. ³⁷ And behold, a woman in the city who was a sinner, when she knew that *Jesus* sat at the table in the Pharisee’s house, brought an alabaster flask of fragrant oil, ³⁸ and stood at His feet behind *Him* weeping; and she began to wash His feet with her tears, and wiped *them* with the hair of her head; and she kissed His feet and anointed *them* with the fragrant oil. ³⁹ Now when the Pharisee who had invited Him saw *this*, he spoke to himself, saying, “This Man, if He were a prophet, would know who and what manner of woman *this is* who is touching Him, for she is a sinner.”

⁴⁰ And Jesus answered and said to him, “Simon, I have something to say to you.”

So he said, “Teacher, say it.”

⁴¹ “There was a certain creditor who had two debtors. One owed five hundred denarii, and the other fifty. ⁴² And when they had nothing with which to repay, he freely forgave them both. Tell Me, therefore, which of them will love him more?”

⁴³ Simon answered and said, “I suppose the *one* whom he forgave more.”

And He said to him, “You have rightly judged.” ⁴⁴ Then He turned to the woman and said to Simon, “Do you see this woman? I entered your house; you gave Me no water for My feet, but she has washed My feet with her tears and wiped *them* with the hair of her head. ⁴⁵ You gave Me no kiss, but this woman has not ceased to kiss My feet since the time I came in. ⁴⁶ You did not anoint My head with oil, but this woman has anointed My feet with fragrant oil. ⁴⁷ Therefore I say to you, her sins, which *are* many, are forgiven, for she loved much. But to whom little is forgiven, *the same* loves little.”

⁴⁸ Then He said to her, “Your sins are forgiven.”

⁴⁹ And those who sat at the table with Him began to say to themselves, “Who is this who even forgives sins?”

⁵⁰ Then He said to the woman, “Your faith has saved you. Go in peace.”” (NKJV)

WHO WAS THIS MARY? IT WAS THE SISTER OF LAZARUS AND MARTHA.

John 11: 1 - 3 New King James Version

“11 Now a certain *man* was sick, Lazarus of Bethany, the town of Mary and her sister Martha. ² It was *that* Mary who anointed the Lord with fragrant oil and wiped His feet with her hair, whose brother Lazarus was sick. ³ Therefore the sisters sent to Him, saying, “Lord, behold, he whom You love is sick.”” (NKJV)

LET’S LOOK AT WHAT PRECEDED CHRIST’S LAST PASSOVER (THE LAST SUPPER):

Matthew 26: 1-16 New King James Version (NKJV) reads:

“26 Now it came to pass, when Jesus had finished all these sayings, *that* He said to His disciples, ² “You know that after two days is the Passover, and the Son of Man will be delivered up to be crucified.”

³ Then the chief priests, ^[a] the scribes, and the elders of the people assembled at the palace of the high priest, who was called Caiaphas, ⁴ and plotted to take Jesus by ^[b] trickery and kill *Him*. ⁵ But they said, “Not during the feast, lest there be an uproar among the people.”

⁶ And when Jesus was in Bethany at the house of Simon the leper, ⁷ a woman came to Him having an alabaster flask of very costly fragrant oil, and she poured *it* on His head as He sat *at the table*. ⁸ But when HIS DISCIPLES saw *it*, they were indignant, saying, “Why this waste? ⁹ For this fragrant oil might have been sold for much and given to *the poor*.”

¹⁰ But when Jesus was aware of *it*, He said to them, “Why do you trouble the woman? For she has done a good work for Me. ¹¹ For you have the poor with you always, but Me you do not have always. ¹² For in pouring this fragrant oil on My body, she did *it* for My burial. ¹³ Assuredly, I say to you, wherever this gospel is preached

in the whole world, what this woman has done will also be told as a memorial to her.”

¹⁴ Then one of the twelve, called Judas Iscariot, went to the chief priests ¹⁵ and said, “What are you willing to give me if I deliver Him to you?” And they counted out to him thirty pieces of silver. ¹⁶ So from that time he sought opportunity to betray Him.” (NKJV)

WHY WAS HER ANOINTING OF CHRIST IMPORTANT?

BECAUSE IT WAS AN ACT OF A PROPHET. IN THE OLD TESTAMENT, THE PROPHET SAMUEL WAS SENT TO ANOINT THE FIRST king – king SAUL. (1 SAMUEL CHAPTER 9)

IN THE NEW TESTAMENT, GOD SENT A WOMAN TO ANOINT THE KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS BEFORE HE ENTERED HIS KINGDOM UPON HIS DEATH THROUGH CRUCIFIXION.

SO, WHO WAS THE FIRST PERSON TO SEE THE RISEN CHRIST?

THE ANSWER: MARY MAGDALENE

Mark 16: 9 - 18 New King James Version

⁹ [c] Now when *He* rose early on the first *day* of the week, **He appeared first to Mary Magdalene, out of whom He had cast seven demons.** ¹⁰ She went and told those who had been with Him, as they mourned and wept. ¹¹ And when they heard that He was alive and had been seen by her, **they did not believe.**

¹² After that, He appeared in another form to two of them as they walked and went into the country. ¹³ And they went and told *it* to the rest, *but* they did not believe them either.

¹⁴ Later He appeared to the eleven as they sat at the table; and He rebuked their unbelief and hardness of heart, because they did not believe those who had seen Him after He had risen. ¹⁵ And He said to

them, “Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature. ¹⁶ He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned. ¹⁷ And these signs will follow those who ^[d]believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; ¹⁸ they^[e] will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover.”” (NKJV)

MARY MAGDALENE HAD BEEN HEALED BY CHRIST AND REMAINED A FOLLOWER OF CHRIST.

Luke 8: 1 – 3 New King James Version

“8 Now it came to pass, afterward, that He went through every city and village, preaching and ^[a]bringing the glad tidings of the kingdom of God. **And the twelve *were* with Him, ² and certain women who had been healed of evil spirits and ^[b]infirmities—Mary called Magdalene, out of whom had come seven demons, ³ and Joanna the wife of Chuza, Herod’s steward, and Susanna, and many others who provided for ^[c]Him from their ^[d]substance.” (NKJV)**

MARY MAGDALENE BEING THE FIRST ONE TO SEE HIM IS CONFIRMED IN JOHN 20: 1-18.

John 20: 1 - 18 New King James Version

“20 Now the first *day* of the week Mary Magdalene went to the tomb early, while it was still dark, and saw *that* the stone had been taken away from the tomb. ² Then she ran and came to Simon Peter, and to the other disciple, whom Jesus loved, and said to them, “They have taken away the Lord out of the tomb, and we do not know where they have laid Him.”

³ Peter therefore went out, and the other disciple, and were going to the tomb. ⁴ So they both ran together, and the other disciple outran Peter and came to the tomb first. ⁵ And he, stooping down and looking in, saw the linen cloths lying *there*; yet he did not go in. ⁶ Then Simon Peter came, following him, and went into the tomb; and he saw the linen cloths lying *there*, ⁷ and the ^[a]handkerchief that had been around His head, not lying with the linen cloths, but folded together in a place by itself. ⁸ Then the other disciple, who came to the tomb first, went in also; and he saw and believed. ⁹ For as yet they did not ^[b]know the Scripture, that He must rise again from the dead. ¹⁰ Then the disciples went away again to their own homes.

Mary Magdalene Sees the Risen Lord

¹¹ But Mary stood outside by the tomb weeping, and as she wept she stooped down *and looked* into the tomb. ¹² And she saw two angels in white sitting, one at the head and the other at the feet, where the body of Jesus had lain. ¹³ Then they said to her, “Woman, why are you weeping?”

She said to them, “Because they have taken away my Lord, and I do not know where they have laid Him.”

¹⁴ Now when she had said this, she turned around and saw Jesus standing *there*, and did not know that it was Jesus. ¹⁵ Jesus said to her, “Woman, why are you weeping? Whom are you seeking?”

She, supposing Him to be the gardener, said to Him, “Sir, if You have carried Him away, tell me where You have laid Him, and I will take Him away.”

¹⁶ Jesus said to her, “Mary!”

She turned and said to ^[c]Him, “Rabboni!” (which is to say, Teacher).

¹⁷ Jesus said to her, “Do not cling to Me, for I have not yet ascended to My Father; but go to My brethren and say to them, ‘I am ascending to My Father and your Father, and *to* My God and your God.’ ”

¹⁸ Mary Magdalene came and told the ^[d]disciples that she had seen the Lord, and *that* He had spoken these things to her.” (NKJV)

NOW, LET’S GO TO 1 CORINTHIANS 14: 34 – 40 WHERE PAUL SAYS THAT WOMEN CANNOT SPEAK IN CHURCH – THEN LET’S FIND OUT WHAT FOLLOWS THAT STATEMENT.

1 CORINTHIANS 14: 34 – 40 NEW KING JAMES VERSION

³⁴ Let ^[i]your women keep silent in the churches, for they are not permitted to speak; but *they are* to be submissive, **as the law also says.** ³⁵ And if they want to learn something, let them ask their own husbands at home; for it is shameful for women to speak in church.

³⁶ Or did the word of God come *originally* from you? Or *was it* you only that it reached? ³⁷ If anyone thinks himself to be a prophet or spiritual, let him acknowledge that the things which I write to you are the commandments of the Lord. ³⁸ But ^[k]if anyone is ignorant, let him be ignorant.

³⁹ Therefore, brethren, desire earnestly to prophesy, and do not forbid to speak with tongues. ⁴⁰ Let all things be done decently and in order.” (NKJV)

WHAT DOES GOD’S WORD SAY ABOUT THE LAW?

Romans 6:13-15 New King James Version

“¹³ And do not present your members *as* ^[a]instruments of unrighteousness to sin, but present yourselves to God as being alive from the dead, and your members *as* instruments of righteousness to God. ¹⁴ For sin shall not have dominion over you, for you are not under law but under grace.”

¹⁵ What then? Shall we sin because we are not under law but under grace? Certainly not!” (NKJV)

HERE IS WHAT ALSO FOLLOWS THAT STATEMENT IN 1 CORINTHIANS 15:

1 Corinthians 15: 1 – 11 New King James Version

“¹⁵ Moreover, brethren, I declare to you the gospel which I preached to you, which also you received and in which you stand, ² by which also you are saved, if you hold fast that word which I preached to you— unless you believed in vain.

³ For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, ⁴ and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures, ⁵ and that He was seen by ^[a]Cephas, then by the twelve. ⁶ After that He was seen by over five hundred brethren at once, of whom the greater part remain to the present, but some have ^[b]fallen asleep. ⁷ After that He was seen by James, then by all the apostles. ⁸ Then last of all He was seen by me also, as by one born out of due time.

⁹ For I am the least of the apostles, who am not worthy to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God. ¹⁰ But by the grace of God I am what I am, and His grace toward me was not in vain; but I

labored more abundantly than they all, yet not I, but the grace of God *which was* with me. ¹¹ Therefore, whether *it was* I or they, so we preach and so you believed.” (NKJV)

DOES THE APOSTLE PAUL MENTION WHO FIRST SAW THE RISEN CHRIST?

NO! HE DOES NOT MENTION THAT A WOMAN – MARY MAGDALENE SAW THE RISEN CHRIST FIRST!

THE LORD SAID TO ME THIS MORNING, AND I QUOTE: “THAT WAS A BLATANT PREJUDICE AGAINST WOMEN.”

THE LORD DEALT WITH THIS PREJUDICE IN THE WARNING HE HAD ME WRITE TO THIS NATION AND TO THE NATIONS. IT IS FOUND IN THE FIRST CHAPTER CALLED: “SOON AFTER CREATION.”

IT TOOK MANY CENTURIES FOR WOMEN TO PARTIALLY OVERCOME THIS PREJUDICE AND TO FINALLY BE RECOGNIZED AS CITIZENS IN THESE UNITED STATES AND FINALLY IN THE WORLD.

WHAT DID GOD SAY?

Philippians 4:13 New King James Version

**“13 I can do all things
through [a]Christ who
strengthens me.” (NKJV)**

**So, to deny a woman’s capabilities in Christ was
a sin and to deny a man’s capabilities in Christ was a
sin.**

**A fair and equal wage would have been proper
when both women and men were doing the same
job.**

IT SAYS SO IN THE SCRIPTURES!

James 2:1-4 New King James Version

“2 My brethren, do not hold the faith of our Lord Jesus Christ, *the Lord* of glory, with partiality. ² For if there should come into your assembly a man with gold rings, in [a]fine apparel, and there should also come in a poor man in [b]filthy clothes, ³ and you [c]pay attention to the one wearing the fine clothes and say to him, “You sit here in a good place,” and say to the poor man, “You stand there,” or, “Sit here at my footstool,” ⁴ have you not [d]shown partiality among yourselves, and become judges with evil thoughts?”

**1 Timothy 5:20-22 New King James
Version**

“20 Those who are sinning rebuke in the presence of all, that the rest also may fear.

21 I charge *you* before God and the Lord Jesus Christ and the [a]elect angels that you observe these things **without prejudice, doing nothing with partiality. 22 Do not lay hands on anyone hastily, nor share in other people’s sins; keep yourself pure.” (NKJV)**
